TURN PARK ART SPACE

A new cultural and recreational space will welcome the public starting May 14, 2017 in West Stockbridge, MA. Situated on 16 acres of a former quarry, **Turn Park Art Space** features a diverse landscape - hills, meadows, a lake and a 65-foot vertical drop offering breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape.

Turn Park Art Space combines a sculpture park, exhibition venues, and a stone amphitheater for outdoor performances. Conceived and founded by Igor Gomberg and Katya Brezgunova as an art space and a place for exploration for both children and adults, the park will showcase contemporary architecture and sculpture at the foot of the Berkshire Mountains.

Turn Park Art Space is a collaborative project designed by Moscow based architect Alexander Konstantinov and New York / Massachusetts architect Grigori Fateyev. The park was created to establish an ongoing dialogue between visitors, nature and art. A visitor's experience will begin at the Gate House, a modern structure inspired by the Berkshire Hills. Paths wind through fields and woodlands of the park past the amphitheater and the lake. Later stages of the project will include site-specific children's playgrounds and pavilions that house a gallery, a restaurant, a gift shop, and a floating dock.

Turn Park Art Space will be home to a unique collection of outdoor sculptures, as well as ongoing art exhibitions and temporary installations. A program of live music, contemporary theatre and performance is also planned for the park.
